EMERGENCE OF IMU

In October 1991, the Government of India appointed a Committee on Maritime Education and Training COMET; under the Chairmanship of Dr. C.P.Srivatsava - Ex-Secretary General of IMO to study the status of marine training institutions and give recommendations. The Committee made the recommendation for formation of Indian Maritime University. Efforts were taken by the Department of Shipping, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways to make the recommendations a reality.

After an arduous effort, an Act was passed in the Parliament on 12th November 2008, to establish Indian Maritime University (IMU) with its headquarters at Chennai and regional campuses at Chennai, Mumbai, Kolkata and Visakhapatnam. The University was to be a teaching and affiliating University. The University will play a vital role in developing and offering wide range of education courses leading to the award of Degree, Post Graduate Degree and Ph.D. in various disciplines of the maritime industry besides the present. Training courses to be offered to the port and merchant navy personnel and infuse quality in standards in the curriculum and syllabus of the existing courses. Further, the courses offered would be of both in campus and also through distance learning. The University will give adequate focus on applied research which is virtually non-existent at present in the maritime sector in the country. The University would enter into possible collaborations with leading maritime universities/institutions in the world and also with premier National Academic and Research Institutions such as IITs, IIMs etc.

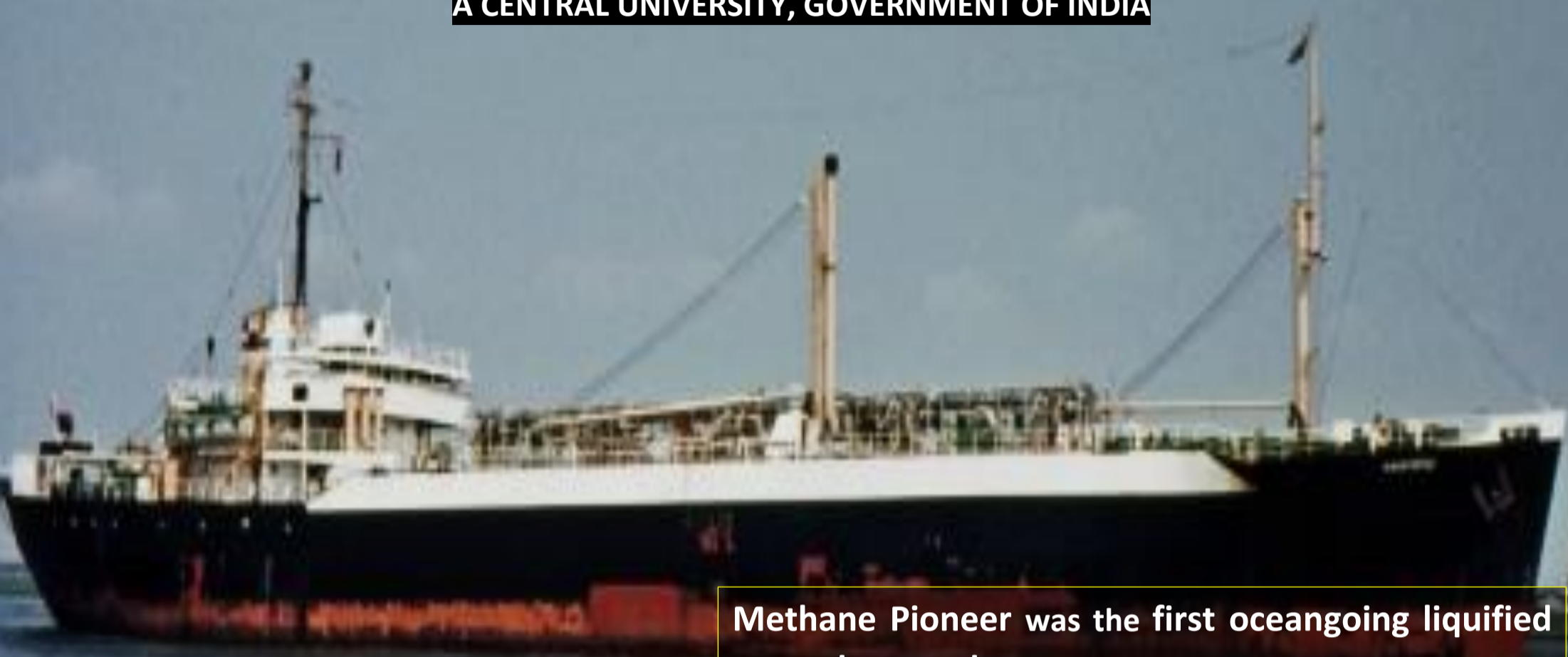
IMU VISAKHAPATNAM CAMPUS

There were 7 renowned legacy Teaching or Research institutes under the Ministry of Shipping, and these were subsumed under the Indian Maritime University in November 2008. The 3 institutes in Mumbai, namely, the Training Ship Chanakya, the Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Advanced Maritime Studies & Research, and the Marine Engineering Research Institute became the Mumbai Campus of the Indian Maritime University. The 2 institutes in Kolkata, namely, the Marine Engineering Research Institute and the Indian Institute of Port Management became the Kolkata Campus of the University. The National Ship Design and Research Centre in Visakhapatnam and the National Maritime Academy in Chennai became the Visakhapatnam and Chennai Campuses respectively of the University. Post-November 2008, Kochi Campus was set up in 2009. The University also has 18 Affiliated Institutes.

Methane Pioneer was the first oceangoing liquified natural gas tanker in the world. Built in 1945 as a cargo ship named **Marline Hitch**, the vessel was renamed **Don Aurelio** and **Nomarti** before being rebuilt in 1958 for the purpose of transporting LNG and operated between 1959 and 1972. On **January 25th 1959**, the **MV Methane Pioneer** left the Calcasieu River with World's first ocean going LNG and sailed to the UK where LNG is delivered.

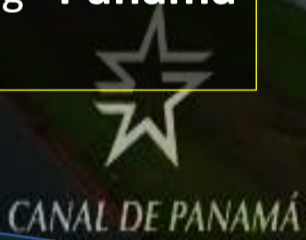

'New technologies for greener shipping' have been chosen as the World Maritime theme for 2022, reflecting the need to support a green transition of the maritime sector into a sustainable future, while leaving no one behind.

In September 1949, the Directorate General of Shipping with its Headquarters at Bombay was established. The Directorate General of Shipping is an attached office of the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Govt. of India and deals with all executive matters, relating to merchant shipping. The Directorate deals with implementation of shipping policy and legislation so as to ensure the safety of life and ships at sea, prevention of marine pollution, promotion of maritime education and training in co-ordination with the International Maritime Organisation, regulation of employment and welfare of seamen, examination and certification of Merchant Navy Officers.

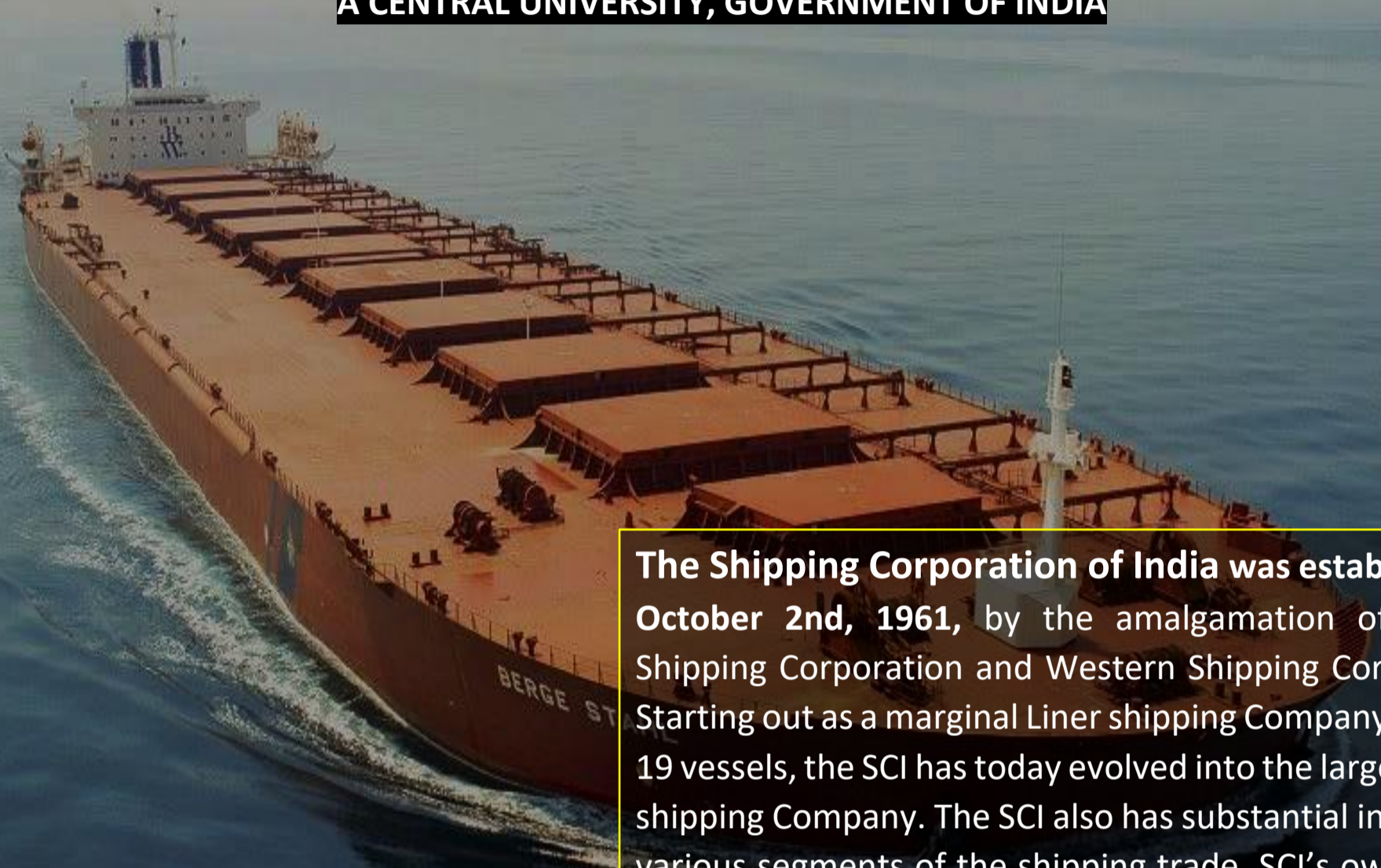
