The Fifth Convocation of the Indian Maritime University, Chennai will be held on Friday, 14th February 2020 at Indian Maritime University, Headquarters, Chennai.

Students who have successfully completed their Degree/Diploma programmes between 1st January 2019 and 31st December 2019 will be admitted to the convocation. It is proposed to give Gold and Silver Medals to First and Second Rankers in each programme, subject to their having obtained 60% and marks overall and having passed all the papers in the first attempt.

Students who have already paid the convocation fee and who wish to receive their Degree/Diploma in-person must register on line through the link provided on IMU Website (www.imu.edu.in). The link for 5th Convocation Portal will be made live on 01.12.2019. The eligible students are requested to register in the online registration portal for receiving degree/diploma in-person on or before 20.01.2020. Thereafter, candidates will be admitted to the Degree/Diploma only in-absentia, for which they have to register online. The link will be available in IMU website and the certificates will be sent to them by speed post. The list of eligible students for award of degree will be published in IMU website on 1.12.2019. With regard to DLP programme, list will be periodically updated on 15.12.19, 30.12.19 and 10.01.2020 after the receipt of second mate marks from the students. No requests, beyond 10.01.2020 will be entertained.

Students who have not paid the convocation fee must also register online and pay the prescribed convocation fee through online mode which is integrated with the online application. No other mode of payment is acceptable. Such candidates have to register and pay convocation fee to obtain their degree/diploma either in-person or in-absentia.

The students registering online to receive Degrees in-person have to indicate as to who shall accompany them at the Convocation otherwise the person accompanying will not be allowed in the Convocation Hall. Please note that due to space constraints, only one person will be allowed to accompany a Candidate.

To supplement these efforts, IMU Campus Directors and the Principals of the Affiliated Institutes are requested to give wide publicity through social media, notice boards so that the maximum number of eligible students apply for the convocation.
