**Circular**

*Sub:* Latest clarifications of the Ministry of Shipping with regard to the service conditions of 'Deemed Deputationists' in IMU in partial modification of the Ministry's Order No.ST-14011/8/2008-MT dated 8.10.2009.

*Ref:* (1) Ministry of Shipping's letter No.ST-14011/8/2008-MT dated 15.07.2016.

(2) Ministry of Shipping's letter No.ST-14011/8/2008-MT dated 02.08.2016.

(3) Ministry of Shipping's letter No.ST-14011/53/2016-MT dated 07.10.2016 regarding the constitution of a Special Cell in the Directorate-General of Shipping, Mumbai.

The Executive Council in its 36<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 28-09-2016 vide Agenda Item No. EC 2016-36-26 considered the latest clarifications given by the Ministry of Shipping, after consulting the Department of Personnel and Training, about the precise status of 'Deemed Deputationists' coming under Section 49(i) of IMU Act, 2008 and resolved as follows:

"The Executive Council took note of the latest clarifications given by the Ministry of Shipping, after consulting the Department of Personnel and Training, about the precise status of 'Deemed Deputationists' coming under Section 49(i) of IMU Act, 2008 – a topic regarding which there was considerable ambiguity and confusion in the past. The gist of the latest clarifications communicated vide the Ministry's letters ref: ST-14011/8/2008-

MT dated 15.07.2016 [read with Rule 20 of the CCS(CCA) Rules, 1965], and ref: ST-14011/8/2008-MT dated 02.08.2016 is as follows:

1. 'Deemed Deputationists' are not eligible for promotion to IMU posts unless they opt for IMU service conditions under Section 49(iii) of the IMU Act, 2008.
2. If 'Deemed Deputationists' do not opt for IMU service conditions under Section 49(iii), then they are eligible only for the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme (MACPS) which should be got approved by DG Shipping hereafter.
3. Suspension and Disciplinary proceedings of Govt. servants on deputation are governed by Rule 20 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965. This will apply to 'Deemed Deputationists' also. According to this rule, the borrowing authority shall have the powers of the appointing authority for the purpose of placing Govt. servants under suspension, and of the disciplinary authority for the purpose of conducting disciplinary proceedings against them. The borrowing authority may impose a minor penalty but only after consultation with the lending authority. The imposition of a major penalty can be done only by the lending authority. So, in the case of 'Deemed Deputationists', IMU is the borrowing authority which will have the powers of the appointing authority for placing 'Deemed Deputationists' under suspension and of the disciplinary authority for conducting disciplinary proceedings. The Ministry of Shipping has clarified that DG (Shipping) will be the 'disciplinary authority' and the Ministry will be the 'appellate authority' in respect of disciplinary cases.

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4. DG (Shipping) shall be the competent authority for processing pension cases of 'Deemed Deputationists' hereafter.

The Executive Council noted that after the formation of IMU, between November 2010 and May 2011, options were already sought by IMU administration from the employees of all the 7 legacy institutes as to whether they would like to continue under their present service conditions [S.49(i) or S.49(ii)] or opt for IMU's service conditions under S.49(iii). None of the 'deemed deputationists' [159 in IMU Mumbai Campus and 112 in IMU Kolkata Campus at the time of creation of IMU on 14.11.2008] opted to join IMU's service conditions under S.49(iii). The Executive Council resolved that such options can be sought only once and need not be sought again."

The reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited communicates the constitution of a Special Cell in DG Shipping's Office to deal the MACP, Pay Fixation and Pension cases of 'Deemed Deputationists'.

Copies of the 3 references cited are enclosed. This Circular together with its enclosures should be brought to the notice of the 'Deemed Deputationists' by displaying the same on the Office Notice Boards. A copy of the same will also be displayed on IMU Website.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2009 on the subject mentioned above and Vice Chancellor's IMU letter No. IMU/VC/Deemed Deputationists/2016 dated 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 regarding service conditions of 'Deemed Deputatonists' under Section 49(i) of IMU Act 2008 and to say that the following proposals were referred to Department of Personnel & Training (DoP&T) for their advice:

(i) Disciplinary Authority/Appellate Authority as under:-

	Disciplinary Authority	Appellate Authority
Upto Group 'B'	Registrar, IMU	VC, IMU and Executive Council.
Group 'A'	VC, IMU and Executive Council	Ministry of Shipping

(ii) Full power to VC, IMU for purposes of promotion and confirmation.

2. Regarding Disciplinary Authority, DoP&T has clarified that disciplinary proceeding in the case of deputation is governed under the Rule 20 of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965(copy enclosed). The borrowing authority has the power to initiate proceedings against such persons but cannot impose (i) a minor penalty without consulting the lending authority (ii) if the proposal is to impose a major penalty, the services of the employees will be re-placed at the disposal of the lending authority. This is without prejudice to any special terms of the deemed deputation. This clarification made by DOPT may be read with Ministry's Order No.ST-14011/8/2008-MT dated 08/10/2009(copy enclosed) and Ministry's letter of even number dated 08/06/2012(copy enclosed) whereby DG (Shipping) will be Disciplinary Authority over all 'Deemed Deputationists'.


3. On the matter of promotion, the DoP&T has observed that IMU shall process the cases of promotion of the employees who will continue on deemed deputation and will forward the same to the Government for approval. Accordingly, the officers transferred under Section 49(i) of IMU Act, 2008 to the University and who continue as 'Deemed Deputationists' can be given the benefit of ACP/MACP only.

4. In view of the above and with the approval of the competent authority the following is now being conveyed to IMU for necessary action:-

- (i) IMU may prepare the list of all eligible deemed deputationists who are due for MACP.
- (ii) IMU will hold DPC meeting for grant of MACP as per rule for all such deemed deputationists. However, before confirming the MACP proceedings, IMU must seek and obtain the option from the Deemed Deputationists whether they want to continue as Deemed Deputaionists or join the University as per the service conditions of the University. IMU will send the DPC proceeding in their case to Director General of Shipping (DGS), Mumbai
- (iii) DGS, in its capacity as competent authority, shall confirm the DPC proceedings sent by IMU in the light of the option exercised by the Deemed Deputationists to continue as Deemed Deputationists.
- (iv) For Deemed Deputationists not due for MACP, IMU may take their option as to whether they would like to be treated as Deemed Deputatiionists or as employees of IMU. Those who continue as Deemed Deputationists, would be eligible only for MACP benefits while those who opt to be treated as IMU employees would be entitled to regular promotion under IMU services as per rules under the IMU Act 2008.
- (i) DGS, Mumbai will be the Disciplinary Authority and will exercise disciplinary powers over all "Deemed Deputationists" in IMU,
- (vi) The Appellate Authority in respect of all disciplinary cases relating to against such 'Deemed Deputationists' in IMU shall be 'Ministry of Shipping'.

20. Provisions regarding officers lent to State Governments, etc.

(1) Where the services of a Government servant are lent by one department to another department or to a State Government or an authority subordinate thereto or to a local or other authority (hereinafter in this rule referred to as "the borrowing authority"), the borrowing authority shall have the powers of the appointing authority for the purpose of placing such Government servant under suspension and of the disciplinary authority for the purpose of conducting a disciplinary proceeding against him:

Provided that the borrowing authority shall forthwith inform the authority which lent the services of the Government servant (hereinafter in this rule referred to as "the lending authority") of the circumstances leading to the order of suspension of such Government servant or the commencement of the disciplinary proceeding, as the case may be.

(2) In the light of the findings in the disciplinary proceeding conducted against the Government servant-

(i) if the borrowing authority is of the opinion that any of the penalties specified in clauses (i) to (iv) of rule 11 should be imposed on the Government servant, it may, after consultation with the lending authority, make such orders on the case as it deems necessary:

Provided that in the event of a difference of opinion between the borrowing authority and the lending authority, the services of the Government servant shall be replaced at the disposal of the lending authority;

(ii) if the borrowing authority is of the opinion that any of the penalties specified in clauses (v) to (ix) of rule 11 should be imposed on the Government servant, it shall replace his services at the disposal of the lending authority and transmit to it the proceedings of the inquiry and thereupon the lending authority may, if it is the disciplinary authority, pass such order thereon as it may deem necessary, or, if it is not the disciplinary authority, submit the case to the disciplinary authority which shall pass such orders on the case as it may deem necessary :

Provided that before passing any such order the disciplinary authority shall comply with the provisions of sub-rules (3) and (4) of rule 15.

EXPLANATION - The disciplinary authority may make an order under this clause on the record of the inquiry transmitted to it by the borrowing authority or after holding such further inquiry as it may deem necessary, as far as may be, in accordance with rule 14.

**ORDER**

**Subject: - Transfer of employees of the four Government Maritime Training Institutes to Indian Maritime University.**

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In pursuance of the decision of the Government of India, the Indian Institute of Maritime Studies (IIMS), Mumbai was registered as a Society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 on 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2002 under this Ministry.

2. The four maritime training institutions, namely, the Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Advance Maritime Studies and Research, Mumbai, Training Ship 'Chanakya', Navi Mumbai and Marine Engineering and Research Institutes located at Kolkata with its branch at Mumbai, which were being run as Government institutions under the control of the Ministry of Shipping were placed within the domain of IIMS, Mumbai.
3. Consequent upon the conversion of the above named four institutes into constituting part of the autonomous body, employees posted in these four institutes were transferred to IIMS, along with their posts on existing terms and conditions on "as is where is basis" on Foreign Service without deputation allowance as per provision contained in Rule 37(A) of CCS (P) Rules w.e.from 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2002 i.e. the date of registration of the Society. The employees have not been absorbed in the said society and continue to be the Government Servant as such.
4. The Government have now established an Indian Maritime University (IMU), at Chennai on 14/11/2008 by an Act of Parliament i.e. Indian Maritime University Act, 2008 (22 of 2008). ① The Training Ship Chanakya, Mumbai, the ② Marine Engineering and Research Institute, Mumbai, the ③ Marine Engineering and Research Institute, Kolkata, Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Advance Maritime Studies, Mumbai, the ④ National Maritime Academy, Chennai, Indian Institute of Port Management, Kolkata and the National Ship Design and Research Centre, Visakhapatnam have been merged with IMU.



5. As per Section 49 of the IMU Act, 2008, the Government employees of Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Advance Maritime Studies and Research, Mumbai, Training Ship Chanakya', Navi Mumbai and Marine Engineering and Research Institutes located at Kolkata with its branch at Mumbai shall stand transferred to IMU with the following options:-

- i. "To continue on deemed deputation in Indian Maritime University on the terms and conditions in force of the Central Government and also continue to retain or to be allotted government residential accommodation on turn and avail of the Central Government Health Scheme facilities till their retirement".
- ii. "All employees shall have the option to join University as per the service conditions of the University".


6. Keeping in view the above, the Government employees of these four institutes presently posted in IIMS on deemed deputation are transferred to IMU subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- i. The employees shall stand transferred to IMU along with their posts on existing terms & conditions on Foreign Service without deputation allowances w.e.f. 14/11/2008 i.e. the date of formation of IMU. The deemed deputation shall continue till their final absorption to IMU.
- ii. The employees who opt for absorption in the IMU, their pensionary benefits will be regulated as per Rule 37-A of CCS (P) Rules 1972.
- iii. Those employees who exercise the option to continue as Government Servant till their retirement and do not join IMU, they will continue on deemed deputation till their retirement.
- iv. During the period of deemed deputation, the employees shall continue, subject to all rules and regulations as are applicable to Government servants including CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965. Their pay and allowances will be governed by the existing rules and regulations and orders of the Government.
- v. All the employees, till they are on deemed deputation shall continue to avail CGHS facilities and continuous to retain or to be allotted Govt. Residential Accommodation on turn.
- vi. The existing Disciplinary Authority/Appellate Authority/Revisional Authority will continue to exercise Disciplinary/Appellate/Revisional powers jurisdiction over all such employees till they are on deemed deputation.

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- vii. The IMU shall have full powers and authority to effect transfer of all the staff of all levels working under it and will exercise control and supervision of its staff working against these posts.
- viii. The IMU shall forward the proposals for promotion / confirmation along with the requisite documents in r/o the deemed deputationists to the competent authorities in the Government for approval which will process the proposals in accordance with the existing recruitment rules.
- ix. In respect of employees who exercise an option to be absorbed in IMU will be governed by the service rules of IMU and hence the IMU will fill up the posts in accordance with the Recruitment Rules of the University.

7. These orders come into effect with effect from 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2008 and are issued with the approval of Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare, Department of Personal and Training and Department of Legal Affairs vide their UO No. 4/5/2009-P&PW (D) dated 13.1.2009, AB-14017/37/2009-Estt (RR) dated 6.10.2009, Dy. No. 10618/09(A) dated 18.6.2009 respectively.





Sir,

I am directed to refer to order No.ST-14011/8/2008-MT dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2009 specifying the terms and conditions of the merger of four Maritime Institutions into IMU. The para 6 of the said letter (copy enclosed) provides that the employees of the four institutions at that time posted at IIMS on deemed deputation are transferred to IMU subject to the specified terms and conditions mentioned therein. One of the conditions stipulates that existing Disciplinary authority/Appellate Authority/Revisional Authority will continue to exercise the relevant powers and jurisdiction over all such employees till they are on deemed deputation.

2. It is understood that all the case record relating to a vigilance case against Capt. Bakshi, earlier posted at 'T.S. Chanakya' have been sent by DG(S) to IMU at the time of formation of IMU. However, since in terms of the order dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2009 mentioned above the disciplinary powers are continued to be vested in DG(S), it has been desired that all the relevant case record may be transferred back to DG(S) i.e. Disciplinary Authority so that appropriate action in the matter is taken and the whole issue is brought to its logical end. It is learnt that DG(S) has also written to IMU in this regard.

3. An early action in the matter may be taken under intimation to this Ministry. A copy of this letter is also being endorsed to DG(S) so that proper coordinated action may be taken in the matter.





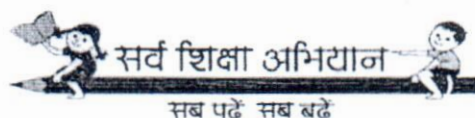
