**Circular**

**IMU's 9<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day Celebrations on 14th November 2016**

The Indian Maritime University was set up on 14.11.2008 and therefore celebrates its **Foundation Day** every year on 14<sup>th</sup> November. In a departure from the previous practice of celebrating it separately in each Campus, in 2014, the Foundation Day was celebrated at Chennai with the involvement of all the Campus Directors. And, for the first time, an **Inter -Campus Cultural Competition** was conducted for students of IMU as part of the Foundation Day which was a grand Success. This year, it is again proposed to celebrate IMU's 9<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day at Chennai 14.11.2016, and to conduct an Inter-Campus Cultural Competition in the following 12 Cultural: 1. Debate, 2. General Quiz, 3. Just a Minute, 4. Dumb Charade, 5. Sketching, 6. Painting, 7. Collage, 8. Standup Comedy, 9. Mimicry, 10. Singing, 11. Solo Dance and 12. Group Dance. The number of participants/teams allowed for each Campus for each event and the approximate duration of each event during the 'Finals' to be held at Chennai are indicated in the **Annexure** to this Circular.

In this connection, the following instructions are issued:

1. Individual Campuses must select their top 2 Participants or 1 Team (as the case may be) for each Cultural event by holding 'Heats'/Preliminary competitions at their Campus level. This should be done before 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 and the names of participants from the Campus should be intimated to IMU HQ before 5 PM on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016.

2. The 'Heats'/Preliminary competitions should be conducted in a transparent and fair manner with the active involvement of students of all Programmes and all batches including the 1<sup>st</sup> year students.
3. The expenditure for the conduct of the preliminary competitions at the Campus level shall be borne by the respective Campuses from the Campus Development Fund (Account No.6).
4. A Campus should not depute participants in excess of the numbers specified.
5. The Campus Director is invited to attend the Foundation Day celebrations at IMU HQ along with two Faculty members and four support staff (instructors /warden/ non-teaching staff). The Faculty member and the support staff will be responsible for the roll call and discipline of participants all through the duration of the 'Finals'.
6. The cost of 'to and fro' passage to Chennai of the visiting teams (including Campus Directors etc} will be reimbursed by IMU HQ. All expenses for the conduct of the 'Finals' at Chennai including boarding & lodging will be borne by IMU HQ.
7. Campus Directors should plan the trip of their participants to Chennai in advance so as to reach IMU-Chennai by the afternoon of 12th November 2016 and depart from Chennai in the forenoon of 15th November, 2016. A briefing session for all participants will be held at IMU HQ on 12th November evening.
8. The 'Finals' of the events will be held throughout 13th November with a few events on 14th November forenoon. The winning teams of some of the cultural events will be required to perform on 14th November at the time of the 9th Foundation Day celebrations in the presence of the Chief Guest.

9. Handsome prizes will be awarded to the winners and runners-up of each event. In addition, there will also be an Individual Championship Award and an overall Championship Rolling Trophy to the Best Campus.

All Campus Directors are requested to make the 9<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day celebrations 2016 and the Inter-Campus Cultural Competition a grand success. A Nodal Officer from each campus may be nominated for coordinating with the Headquarters for the above. **This circular as well as the Annexure should be displayed on Notice Boards for the information of all the students.**
