

## IMU Admissions UG-Except BBA

### **Pending Seat Allotment – New Procedure**

The 856 seats for UG except BBA were released in the first list. The vacant seats break-up which is in offer now is as follows:

Unlike previous years, this year after the first list there will be now opening of **ADVANCE PROGRAM FEE CONFIRMATION PORTAL**. This new procedure is called FINAL CONFIRMATION PROCEDURE and the following system is being implemented:

- a) There will be no second list and third list release.
- b) Candidates whose name have appeared in first list are not eligible for this registration in advance program fee confirmation.**
- c) All those who have applied for counselling (who have paid Rs 10,000) and not allotted any seat in First List, now have to pay Rs 25,000 as confirmation fee in advance and register for the above seats by clicking the link <https://imucetam20.onlineregistrationform.org/IMUCOU/>
- d) After registration, the advance-program fee will be acknowledged by IMU.
- e) After the closure of the registration, there may be more applicants than the seat available.
- f) All the candidates who have registered by paying advance confirmation fees, will be then ranked as per the merit and allotted seat as per their preference and seat availability according to their category for these 249 seats in one-go.
- g) The successful candidates will be informed and the confirmed list will be released on the website on 12.11.2020(tentatively).
- h) All the unsuccessful candidates will be refunded their fees paid {Rs. 25,000 + Rs 9000 (Rs 1000 will be deducted as processing fees)}.
- i) In other words, the candidates who registered will **EITHER** get the **SEAT, OR** the **REFUND** of fees (Rs 34,000).
- j) The seat allotment will be done after the cut-off date of payment of confirmation fees.
- k) **Waiting list** : All candidates who are not allotted any seat in the confirmed list but wish to be in waiting list, may do so by keeping the confirmation amount of Rs 25000 with

IMU for 45 days from the release of the final list, from which the admissions may be considered in case of further drop-outs. The request of withdrawal of refund of Rs 25000 during this 45-day period will make the candidate ineligible to be a part of the waiting list, from the day of the request. There will not be any publishing of waiting list but the pool will be maintained. Only candidates getting the seats from waiting list will be informed.

- l) The candidates of Provisional Rank List – Part B list will need to register for counselling process first (**not applicable for those who have already paid counselling fees of Rs 10,000**) by clicking the link <https://imucetam20.onlineregistrationform.org/IMUCOU/> After registering they need to follow the same process as mentioned in point C.
- m) It is clarified that Provisional Rank List – Part B is not second list and is only extension of initial provisional rank list published on 25.09.2020.
- n) In case of any doubt about this procedure please mail to [counselling2020@imu.ac.in](mailto:counselling2020@imu.ac.in) only and not to any other e-mail id, failing which the mails may go unnoticed.
- o) The seats reserved for Special States (if any) will be allotted in this list and will be given preference for their choices.
- p) The advance registration portal is available for registration from 05.11.2020 to 09.11.2020. Candidates are advised to register at the earliest to avoid the last minute rush as the technical glitches observed on the last day cannot be addressed and hence IMU will not be responsible for such problems. The candidates are advised to regularly visit website for updates and regularly check their spam mail boxes also.
