Sub: Reply to the queries on conduct of End Semester/ Arrear/ Intermediate Examination - reg.

The COVID-19 pandemic hit India in Feb this year, ever since, the whole dynamics of Higher Education system all over the Country has gone into a complete transformation in a very short span of time. For every change, there is a need for all stakeholders to slowly adapt to the new scenario. Indian Maritime University also had to change its pattern of Education system and towards this initially introduced the online mode of teaching. As the Final Semester students are already seeking admission for further Higher studies or already have undergone Campus Interview awaiting placement, Indian Maritime University in order to ensure that the student's future is not put at stake has already planned to conduct the Final Semester Examinations through Online mode. The following clarifications are being presented to the students in order to put their minds at ease with regard to IMU's decision in conducting Examination and its related issues:

1. Final Semester Examinations (Theory):

It is informed that IMU is working on conduct of online Proctored (MCQ) Examinations for the theory subjects for the Final Semester students. This examinations will be taken by the students at their residence through Laptop/ Desktop computer. Tentatively, it is proposed to conduct these examinations during Second Week of September 2020 and results will be published within a week from the last date of the examinations. Students who do not have Laptop/Desktop may arrange the same from the friends/ relatives. Detailed guidelines, instructions, time-table for the conduct of examinations will be uploaded in the IMU website, once the preparatory work is completed by IMU. In case, students unable to attend this online examinations due to non-availability of Laptop/Desktop or other reasons, they will be permitted to write the pen-paper mode examinations once the normalcy is restored.

2. Arrear Examinations:

IMU is devising detailed methodology for conduct of arrear examinations for all the semesters and also for all the regulations. The details regarding methodology, instructions, time-table will be published in IMU Website in due course.

3. Examinations for intermediate Semesters:

IMU is also devising detailed methodology, procedure for examinations for Intermediate Semesters for various Programmes of IMU. The details regarding methodology, instructions, time-table will be published in IMU Website in due course.

4. DLP Examinations:

DLP examinations will be conducted only through pen-paper mode once the normalcy is restored. Detailed Instructions will be issued based on the Government of India guidelines.

General Instructions to the Students:

- a. On completion of preparatory works for conduct of examinations, as mentioned above and receipt of approval of the Competent Authority, IMU will immediately publish the instructions on IMU Website. Hence, students are requested to prepare for the examinations.
- b. Since all the information pertaining to examinations will be published in IMU Website, Students/ Parents are requested not to send emails to the University Authorities.
