Sub: Revised Ordinance on 'Performance-based Reward for the meritorious students of Indian Maritime University Campuses'.

Ref: EC Agenda No: EC 2017-38-22 of 38th EC meeting held on 28.03.2017

The Executive Council resolved to approve the revised Ordinance on 'Performance-based Reward for the meritorious students of Indian Maritime University Campuses' is as follows:

Ordinance 80 of 2015

[Executive Council resolution No.EC 2015-33-27 dated 23-12-2015 and amended vide EC 2016-36-18 dated 28-09-2016 and.EC 2017-38-22 dated 28-03-2017]

"Performance-based Reward for students of IMU Campuses

- The 'Performance-based Reward' Scheme is applicable to students of IMU Campuses only, and is aimed at motivating the students to continue to perform meritoriously from semester to semester; to maintain discipline and good conduct; and to reduce the bank loan burden of meritorious students.
- 2. As it is a reward, it will be based purely on academic performance and will not be linked to economic means.

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- As it is a reward for pure merit, it will not be a bar to a student getting any scholarship/freeship/studentship/fellowship, etc. from any other source.
- 4. It will be for a semester only, based on the academic performance in the immediate previous semester examination. It follows that the reward will not be given in the first semester of any programme; it will be given from the second semester onwards.
- 5. It will apply only to UG and PG Degree programmes of duration 2 years or more. Thus 1-year Diploma programmes Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS) and Post Graduate Diploma in Marine Engineering (PGDME) will not be covered by it.
- 6. To be eligible for this reward, the student must have secured at least 75% marks overall in the immediate previous semester examination.
- At the time of grant, the student should not have any arrear papers relating to the immediate previous semester examination or the earlier semester examinations.
- 8. Any student who has suffered any punishment for ragging or examination malpractices or has indulged in any act of gross indiscipline or misconduct, shall be permanently ineligible for this reward. A 'NOC' from the Campus Directors shall be obtained in this regard.
- Based on the results of the immediate previous semester examination, the top rankers in each batch in all UG as well as PG Degree Programmes will get a 'Performance-based Reward' of Rs.1 lakh per head.

- 10.Provided however that in respect of BBA (Logistics, Retailing & E-Commerce), M.Sc (Commercial Shipping & Logistics) and M.Tech (Marine Technology & Management), the *top rankers* in each batch will get a 'Performance-based Reward' of Rs.40,000/-, Rs.50,000/- and Rs.1 lakh respectively per head.
- 11. The total number of candidates in the order of merit who will get a 'Performance-based Reward' of Rs. 75,000/- per head in each batch in each programme, and who will get a 'Performance-based Reward' of Rs. 50,000/- per head in each batch in each programme, will be as per the Table below:

12.Provided however that in respect of BBA (Logistics, Retailing & E-Commerce), M.Sc (Commercial Shipping & Logistics) and M.Tech (Marine Technology & Management), the total number of candidates in the order of merit (other than 'toppers') who will get 'Performance-based Rewards' in each batch in each programme and the amount of reward per head, will be as per the Table below:

- 13. For all the three types of 'Performance-based Rewards', the two MBA programmes in Table 1, which have a large number of common papers, will be treated as a single 'programme'; so also the two M.Tech programmes in Table 1.
- 14. For determining the 'toppers' and the other rewardees, the University as a whole shall be treated as the unit; not the individual Campuses.
- 15. In the event of a 'tie' for 'topper', all the students will get the reward. In the event of a 'tie' for the other 2 types of Performance-based Reward, the 'tie' shall be resolved by arranging the students in the descending order of the total external examination marks for Theory papers of the particular semester. If there is still a 'tie' the same shall be resolved by arranging the students in the descending order of percentage of attendance for that semester.
- 16. The student is not entitled to set off his eligible 'Performance-based Reward amount' against his semester fees and other dues payable to IMU. However IMU reserves the right to recover any of its dues from the student out of his 'Performance-based reward'."

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This will come into effect from the December 2017 Semester examinations of the Academic Year 2017-18.
