The Computer-based Common Entrance Test (CET) for admissions to the MBA(PSM), MBA(ITL) and M.Sc(CSL) Programmes for August 2020 Batch was held in 12 cities across India on 4th Jan 2020. The results of the CET have been published on 6th Jan 2020 on IMU's Website.

Candidates who have passed the IMU's CET-2020, and who fulfil the eligibility criteria relating to age, educational qualifications, medical fitness etc. as per IMU norms shall alone be eligible for admissions to the above Programmes of IMU Campuses for August 2020 batch.

From 2014 onwards, IMU has switched over to Online Counselling so that all the candidates need not come to Chennai physically for the Counselling which in the past had caused hardship to candidates. It is also transparent and fair to the Affiliated Institutes.

The total number of seats available in IMU Campuses for MBA(PSM/ITL) and M.Sc(CSL) programmes is:

MBA(PSM)	: 78

The link titled "**Registration for Online Counselling for Admissions to MBA and M.Sc(CSL) Programmes of IMU Campuses**" in IMU's website is active from **22nd January 2020**. The last date for submitting Online Counselling options is on Thursday **30th January 2020**.

IMU's Online Counselling :

Online Counselling will be limited to admissions to IMU Campuses only. Online Counselling is the process which happens in two phases:

IMU-CET qualified Candidates will be provided a portal through which they can select the Campus(es) where they desire to take admission. Candidates have to register on this portal by making Online payment of Rs.10,000/- towards Counselling Fee (***Non-refundable to those candidates who have been allotted a seat in any of the lists***).

The Candidate will make online payment of Counselling Fee of Rs.10,000/- (Non-refundable to those candidates who have been allotted a seat in any of the lists) and Programme Fee of Rs.25,000/- (Non Refundable) directly to IMU Headquarters via Net Banking / Credit Card / Debit Card immediately after the publication of the Admission Lists.

The Candidate should choose multiple options in the order of their preference for IMU Campuses where the above desired Programmes are being conducted.

Based on the Rank, Social Category of the Candidate and availability of seats, a seat will be allotted provisionally to the Candidate from the list of options provided by them. IMU generally publishes 2 admissions list and a 3rd List, if required. After allotment of seat the Candidate will be required to **confirm the seat by paying the Programme Fee of Rs. 25,000/- (Non-refundable)**. Candidates who confirm their seat will be issued with the Provisional Allotment Letter which has to be produced at the time of verification of original mark sheets and certificates, physical fitness certificate, etc. on the date mentioned in the Letter.

There could be a possibility that the Candidate may not get a seat in the most preferred Programme/Campus in the First Admission List. They could stand a chance for allotment of seat in the Second or Third Admission List. For this it is mandatory that the Candidate should have confirmed the seat allotted in the First or Previous Admission List by paying the Programme Fee of Rs.25,000/-

Candidates who fail to confirm by the due date will be treated as drop out and will not be considered for subsequent Admission Lists for upgradation or seat allotment due to drop outs.

Candidates who have paid the Programme Fee of Rs.25,000/- and have got upgraded in the subsequent Admission List will not have to pay the Programme Fee again. It is advised that Candidates must choose as many options as possible based on fulfilment of eligibility criteria to increase their chances for allotment of seat.

Separate detailed instructions for Certificate Verification will be issued in due course.
