Sub: Guidelines for admission of foreign students in pre-sea courses B.Tech. (Marine Engineering), B.Sc. (Nautical Science) and DNS programmes of the Affiliated Colleges of IMU - reg.

1. The Executive Council during its 69th meeting held on 11/04/2023 has approved for permitting admission of foreign students to pre-sea courses DNS, B.Sc. (Nautical Science) and B.Tech (Marine Engineering) programmes of the Affiliated Institutes of IMU as recommended by the Academic Council in its 35th meeting held on 02.03.2023.
2. The guidelines approved by the Executive Council are as follows:
 - (a) The affiliated colleges of IMU are allowed to admit Foreign Nationals/Persons of Indian origin/Non-Resident Indians/Overseas Citizen of India in DNS, B.Sc. Nautical Science and B.Tech. Marine Engineering programmes.
 - (b) The candidates shall fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria prescribed by IMU from time to time.
 - (c) The affiliated colleges are allowed to admit the candidates qualified in any one of the common entrance examinations:
 - (i) IMU-CET conducted by IMU
 - (ii) JEE main examination conducted by NTA
 - (iii) CUET conducted by NTA
 - (iv) SAT examination conducted by the College Board

- (d) The affiliating institutes shall seek permission from Director General (Shipping) and IMU with the details prior to admitting foreign nationals.
- (e) The total number of candidates admitted under both Indian and foreign students categories put together shall be restricted to the sanctioned intake of the programme.
3. All NRI/Foreign students admitted in the colleges are required to register the Students Arrival & submit Form S to Bureau of Immigration in time. It is advised to strictly follow the Rules and Regulations prescribed by Bureau of Immigration, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India from time to time.
 4. The affiliated institutes are required to ensure that the candidates applied have submitted equivalency certificate from AIU for admissions.
 5. The candidates must be physically fit. They should meet the requirements as specified by Director General (Shipping) for sea going courses. They are required to produce certificate of medical fitness from a Doctor approved by Director General (Shipping).
 6. The affiliated institutes admitting foreign students are required to follow the DGS and IMU norms promulgated from time to time.
 7. This is for information and strict compliance before admitting foreign students at affiliated institutes of IMU.
