Sirs,

Sub: IMU Campuses and Affiliated Institutes – Admissions to PG and UG Programmes - August 2015 – Computer based Online Counselling – intimation – reg.

The Computer-based (Online) CET of IMU was conducted successfully on 9^{th} May 2015 and the results were published on 12^{th} May 2015.

The details of candidates who qualified in CET 2015 are as indicated below.

From 2014 onwards, IMU has switched over to **Online Counselling** so that all the candidates need not come to Chennai physically for the Counselling which, in the past, had caused hardship to candidates. It is also transparent and fair to the Affiliated Institutes.

For the Online Counselling, eleven Affiliated Institutes have surrendered a total of 809 seats in various UG Courses except DNS,

since IMU is not holding Online Counselling for DNS programme of Affiliated Institutes this year. The details of the seats surrendered by the Affiliated Institutes are in Annexure I. The total number of seats available in IMU Campuses for UG Courses is 981 and for PG Courses is 190; the details are available in Annexure II.

The link titled "Online Counselling 2015" in IMU's website www.imu.edu.in will be active from Wednesday 20th May 2015 forenoon onwards. The last date for submitting Online Counselling Options is Friday 19th June 2015. The following 15 instructions relating to Online Counselling should be read carefully by one and all.

- Candidates will be required to choose online, the Programme(s) and also Institutes (IMU Campuses/Affiliated Institutes) that they would like to join.
- 2. The details of the Programmes offered by IMU Campuses and those Affiliated Institutes which have surrendered seats for Online *Counselling, Eligibility Criteria for various Programmes and details of Fees for various Programmes charged by IMU are available at the link *Online Counselling 2015".
- For details of Fees charged by Affiliated Institutes, the candidates are required to visit the website of the Affiliated Institutes or communicate with them directly.
- 4. The candidate must first pay a **Counselling Fee of Rs.10,000/-** (non-refundable) to IMU in the manner prescribed before he can choose his Programmes / Institutes online.
- 5. The allotment of candidates to a Programme/College will be done automatically based on (i) rank in the CET, (ii) Category, (iii) choices of Programmes and Institutes, and (iv) the availability of seats. The First List of allotments will be published only after the last date for Online Counselling is over.
- 6. The **Allotment Letter** issued will be <u>strictly provisional and subject to</u> verification of the candidate's original documents and his medical

- fitness.. The candidate will be directed to the nearest IMU Campus or designated Institute for such verification.
- 7. Once the original documents are verified and medical fitness is established, the candidate will be required to pay the **Programme** (non-refundable) **Fee** of **Rs.25,000/Rs.27,500** (as applicable) to IMU, after which the provisional Allotment Letter will be affixed with a seal with the words "**Admission Confirmed**" and attested by an IMU functionary.
- 8. The rest of the fees shall be paid at the time of joining the College (IMU Campus / Affiliated College) where the candidate got admission.
- 9. If the candidate who is issued the provisional Allotment Letter does not report for verification of his original documents and confirmation of his medical fitness within the time prescribed, then the candidate shall be deemed to be a 'dropout' and he shall forgo his seat allotment and forfeit the Counselling Fee. Candidates are therefore advised to strictly adhere to the time limits prescribed.
- 10. IMU will draw up a **Second List** of selected candidates in place of such 'dropouts'. In the Second List, some of the candidates may get **upgraded** i.e. they may get a Programme or College or both (as per their order of preference) which they could not get in the First List.
- 11. If, after his admission is confirmed, the candidate fails to join the College allotted within the time prescribed, the candidate shall forgo his seat allotment and forfeit not only the Counselling Fee but also the Programme Fee already paid. Such a candidate shall also be deemed to be a 'dropout'.
- 12. IMU may draw up a **Third List** of selected candidates for the vacancies arising as a result of dropouts from the Second List or the candidates not joining as per para-13 above.
- 13. Candidates should note that unless they register for Online Counselling and also register with multiple options, they may lose out on their chances of upgradation in the Second List or Third list.

- 14. The decisions of IMU in respect of Counselling and Admissions shall be final.
- 15. Legal disputes, if any, pertaining to Counselling and Admission matters shall fall within the jurisdiction of Chennai Courts only.

It is hoped that the Online Counselling 2015 will be a success.
