CIRCULAR 1518

Sub: IMU – Online Counselling 2015 – First List of Admissions to U.G Programmes in IMU Campuses and in 11 Affiliated Institutes that had surrendered their seats to IMU's Online Counselling – procedure for verification of Original Certificates, Medical Fitness, etc and payment of Programme Fee - reg.

- Ref:** 1) IMU's Circular No.1514, dated 20.05.2015.
2) IMU's First List of Admissions published on 27-06-2015.

Registrations for the Online Counselling for admissions to various U.G programmes in IMU Campuses and Affiliated Institutes got over on Friday 26th June 2015. The **First List** of Admissions was published on IMU's website on **Saturday 27th June 2015**. The following 3 Statements were published:

Statement No.1: *Rank-wise list of Selected Candidates.*

Statement No.2: *Statement showing the names of selected candidates College-wise, Programme-wise.*

Statement No.3: *Statement showing the No. of seats available, No. allotted and Vacancies - College-wise, Programme-wise.*

The term 'College' refers to an IMU Campus or an Affiliated Institute that had surrendered some or all of its seats to IMU's Online Counselling. This year, IMU's Online Counselling was not opened to DNS seats of Affiliated Institutes; they were instead required to fill up the DNS seats on their own.

This year, the total number of *valid registrations* for UG programmes in IMU's Online Counselling was **2220**. This was 38% greater than the 1603 online registrations of 2014 that included DNS for 17 Affiliated Institutes. The number of Affiliated Institutes that had surrendered their seats to IMU's Online Counselling this year was 11.

Two Important Differences:

Two improvements have been made in IMU's Online Counselling 2015 when compared to last year.

1. In 2014, only the First List was published; there was no Second or Third List. The candidates had to either join the College-cum-Programme that they had been allotted as per the First List or drop out. **This year, the vacancies arising from such drop outs will be filled up by publishing a Second List, and if deemed necessary, even a Third List.**
2. To facilitate the drawing up of Second List and Third List in real time, **an Online Data Entry Screen for making entries of candidates who report for verification of Original Certificates, Medical Fitness, etc and payment of Programme Fee within the prescribed time limit has been devised.** The staff of the designated IMU Campus will have to make the online entries then and there as soon as they finish the verification and collect the Programme Fee from a candidate. **On no account should they delay making the online entries or 'bunch' the online entries as it can lead to wrong data about**

the number of vacancies arising due to drop outs, and the correctness of the Second List and the Third List will be affected.

Allotment Letters:

The model Allotment Letters, one for candidates who have been allotted to IMU Campuses as per the First List, and the second for candidates who have been allotted to the 11 Affiliated Institutes as per the First List may be seen in **Annexure I** and **Annexure II** respectively. Campus Directors/Principals of Affiliated Institutes are requested to go through these letters carefully.

While the candidates allotted to IMU Campuses will have to report before the Director of the concerned Campus, the candidates allotted to the 11 Affiliated Institutes will have to report before the Director of the designated IMU Campus as per the **Table** shown below:

The candidates allotted to the 11 Affiliated Institutes should not report directly at the Affiliated Institute; they should first report before the Director of the designated IMU Campus only.

The Affiliated Institute is at liberty to fill up the unfilled seats (as per the First List) on its own with CET-qualified candidates at any time.

Verification Process:

The Campus Directors of Chennai, Cochin, Mumbai and Visakhapatnam Campuses are requested to open **2 separate counters** for verification of Certificates and collection of Programme fee: **one, for candidates selected to the IMU Campus**, and **another, for candidates selected for Affiliated Institutes allotted to their Campus**. The Director of Kolkata Campus may open only one counter for the time being: for candidates selected to Kolkata Campus.

Depending upon the workload, the Campus Directors should post sufficient number of staff in the Verification Counters. **As the work of verification-cum-collection of Programme fee is very important, it should be ensured that only very competent staff are posted to the Verification Counters. They also need to be I.T-savvy as they will be required to make online entries in real time.**

The selected candidates have been directed to report before the Director of the designated IMU Campus between 10 am and 5 pm **from Monday 6th July 2015 to Friday 17th July 2015** for verification of Original

Certificates, Medical Fitness and for payment of Programme Fee of Rs.25,000/-.

Verification of Original Certificates: The following Original Certificates should be produced by the candidates and verified by the IMU staff posted to the Verification Counters.

- *Proof of Age - Birth Certificate/SSLC or equivalent marksheet.*
- *Higher Secondary School or equivalent marksheet.*
- *Community Certificate (for ST, SC and OBC – Non Creamy Layer)*
- *Transfer Certificate*
- *Copy of IMU's CET Admit card/ Hall ticket.*
- *Original of Challan for payment of Online Counselling Fee of Rs.10,000.*
- *Printed copy of Online Counselling particulars.*
- *2 copies of passport size photographs.*

Medical Fitness certificate: Candidates selected for Diploma in Nautical Science, B. Sc (Nautical Science), B. Sc (Maritime Science) and B. Tech (Marine Engineering) should produce a Medical Fitness Certificate with confirmation of eye sight fitness from a panel of Doctors/ Hospitals approved by the Director General of Shipping, Mumbai. Medical Fitness Certificate for other courses such as B.Sc. (Ship Building & Repair) and B.Tech. (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering) can be obtained from any registered medical practitioner.

Programme Fee: Candidates shall pay the prescribed Programme Fee of **Rs. 25,000/-** by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'Indian Maritime University' payable at the city where the Campus is located at the time of Certificate verification. No cheques will be accepted. **Please note that the Programme Fee has been made uniformly Rs.25,000 for all UG and PG programmes from the academic year 2015-16 onwards.** The Programme Fee is payable to IMU each year -

at the beginning of the Academic year – till the completion of the Programme.

Confirmation of Admission:

After the Verification Process and the collection of Programme Fee is over, the provisional letter of admission produced by the candidate will be affixed with a seal with the words **"Admission Confirmed"** and attested by an IMU functionary designated by the Campus Director. *The semester fees, etc need NOT be paid at this stage; they need to be paid only at the time of joining the IMU Campus on Monday 3rd August 2015 or at the time of joining the concerned Affiliated Institute.*

Apart from ensuring the making of prompt online entries relating to the Verification Process-cum-Collection of Programme Fee, Campus Directors must also send a daily progress report to IMU Headquarters by email in the format prescribed.

It shall be the obligatory on the part of the Affiliated Institute which had surrendered seats to IMU's Online Counselling to admit the candidate who produces IMU's letter of admission with the words "Admission Confirmed" on or before Friday 24th July 2015. Refusal to admit the candidates will be viewed seriously and is a ground for initiating disaffiliation proceedings against the Institute.

If the candidate doesn't report at the Affiliated Institute on or before Friday 24th July 2015, and complete the other admission registration formalities of the Institute, the Affiliated Institute shall be free to admit any other CET-qualified candidate in the vacancy.

Publication of Second List:

A candidate who does not complete the formalities of certificate verification and payment of Programme Fee **before Friday 17th July**

2015 will be deemed to be a '**drop out**' and he shall forgo his seat allotment and **forfeit** the Counselling Fee of Rs.10,000/-.

IMU will publish a **Second List** of selected candidates on **Monday 20th July 2015**, in place of such 'dropouts'. In the Second List, some of the candidates may get **upgraded** i.e. they may get a Programme or College or both (as per their order of preference) which they could not get in the First List. **As per the decision of the Executive Council, the Second List will be only for IMU Campuses.**

Only a candidate who has had his certificates verified and paid the Programme Fee is eligible for the benefit of 'upgradation' under the Second List.

If a candidate has reason to believe that he stands a good chance of getting a better Programme or College or both in the **Second List** of admissions to be published by IMU on Monday 20th July 2015, he may wait till the Second List is out before joining the Affiliated Institute. However, this is purely the candidate's decision and neither IMU nor the Affiliated Institute will be responsible if he loses his seat by failing to adhere to the deadline of 24th July 2015 for joining the Affiliated Institute.

If a candidate gets a different Programme or IMU Campus or both based on the **Second List** of admissions and joins it, *the Programme Fee of Rs.25,000 already paid by him should be adjusted, and he need not pay the Programme Fee again.* However if he does not join any Programme in any IMU Campus, then he will forfeit the Programme Fee already paid.

If the Programme that is allotted to a candidate in the Second List has higher eligibility conditions(both in terms of marks and

medical fitness) than what was allotted to him in the First List and for which he has already completed the Certification Verification-cum-payment of Programme Fee formalities, **then his Original Certificates and Medical Fitness will have to be verified once again.** *To give an illustration,* if a candidate got B.Sc (Shipbuilding & Repair) in the First List and B.Sc (Nautical Science) in the Second List, the eligibility conditions both in terms of marks and medical fitness are higher for the latter Programme warranting re-verification of the candidate's Original Certificates and Medical Fitness for B.Sc (Nautical Science). **But this re-verification may be done at the time when the candidate joins the relevant Programme in the IMU Campus.**

If a fresh candidate gets an Allotment Letter as per the Second List, then he will have to report before the Director of the IMU Campus concerned for completing the formalities of verification of his original certificates and medical fitness and payment of Programme Fee of Rs.25,000 as before. **The time limit is from Wednesday 22nd July 2015 to Tuesday 28th July 2015.** Campus Directors should arrange to have the online entries made then and there in this case also in order to ascertain the vacancy position accurately. They must also send a daily progress report to IMU Headquarters by email in the format prescribed.

Publication of Third List

IMU may draw up a **Third List** of selected candidates for the vacancies arising as a result of dropouts from the Second List or the candidates not joining as per the First List. A decision about this will be taken depending on the vacancy position and the time available.

The First Semester classes will commence on **Monday 3rd August 2015.**

Instructions about the verification of Original Certificates, Medical Fitness and collection of Programme Fees from CET-qualified candidates who are directly admitted by the Affiliated Institutes on their own will be issued through a separate Circular.

1. Verification of Original Certificates

The candidate should produce the following original certificates for verification:

2. Medical Fitness certificate

Candidates selected for Diploma in Nautical Science, B. Sc (Nautical Science), B. Sc (Maritime Science) and B. Tech (Marine Engineering) should produce a Medical Fitness Certificate with confirmation of eye sight fitness from a panel of Doctors/Hospitals approved by the Director General of Shipping, Mumbai.

Medical Fitness Certificate for other courses such as B.Sc. (Ship Building & Repair) and B.Tech. (Naval Architecture & Ocean Engineering) can be obtained from any registered medical practitioner.

3. Programme Fee

Candidates shall pay the prescribed Programme Fee of **Rs.25,000/-** by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'Indian Maritime University payable at (the city where the Campus is located)' at the time of Certificate verification. No cheques will be accepted.

The Programme Fee is payable to IMU each year - at the beginning of the Academic year – till the completion of the Programme.

4. First Year Fees

There are 2 semesters – one starting in August and another in February. Over and above the Programme Fee referred to in Para 3 above, the following Semester fees are payable for the 1st and 2nd semester:
