For example, "Communicative English and Sociology", which is a Theory subject in the 1st semester of B Tech (Marine Engineering) course and for which the second revision is applicable, the Subject Code will be: *T2101*.

Under present system, the same Subject Code T2101 is applicable to the following subjects (papers) of various Programmes:
