**Circular No. 1536**

**Sub:** Admissions to UG Programmes directly by Affiliated Institutes – Candidates completed Certificate Verification at designated IMU and still not desirous of joining allotted IMU Campus/ Affiliated Institute - Admission Registration Fee and Programme Fee - Reg.

Any candidate who is directly admitted by the Affiliated Institute has to necessarily pay the Admission Registration Fee of Rs. 10,000/- and Programme Fee of Rs. 25,000/-. Further, the Affiliated Institute has to make out separate consolidated Demand Drafts on behalf of students as per the procedure prescribed in para 4) of the Circular cited 1<sup>st</sup>. There is no exception to these instructions.

Some of the directly admitted candidates may fall under either of the two categories stated below:

- a) The candidate may have registered for IMU's Online Counselling and his/ her name may have appeared in the First Admission List but did not choose to join the IMU Campus/ Institute which was allotted to him/ her.



- b) The candidate may have registered for IMU's Online Counselling; his/ her name may have appeared in the First or Second Admission List; he/ she may have reported to the designated IMU Campus for verification of Certificates and paid the Programme Fee of Rs. 25,000/-; and he/ she may still choose not to join the IMU Campus/ Affiliated Institute which was allotted to him/ her.

As already stated, Affiliated Institutes MUST collect the Admission Registration Fee of Rs. 10,000/- and Programme Fee of Rs. 25,000/- from candidates falling under both these categories. The candidates falling under these two categories can later claim refund of the Online Counselling Fee of Rs. 10,000/- and/ or Programme Fee of Rs. 25,000/ as per the procedure laid down in reference cited 2<sup>nd</sup>.
