- 3. All students would submit their papers first to the Guides, who forward the papers to the concerned Campus Coordinators for submission to the Google Group of the Core Committee.
- 4. Campus Coordinators are requested to submit the papers to <u>core-comm-imo-mock-session@googlegroups.com</u>
- 5. All submissions would be done by the Campus Coordinators to the Core Committee direct submission by participants would not be entertained.
- 6. All papers would be submitted in the PDF (Portable Document Format).
- 7. The PDF file name will follow the following format:

Serial Number: In case of only one team in a category in a Campus it will be by default 1, in case of multiple teams it will be 1/2/3/4... as applicable and decided in the Campus

8. Team's identity needs to be specifically mentioned on the front page of the Paper itself in the section "Submitted By" without any ambiguity. This will follow the same part of Category and Serial Number as given in the file name at Serial 7 above. Names of all the team members would then be written below the same and should be as per the registered data with IMU.

! Instructions for the Campus Coordinators:

- 1. Campus Coordinators shall not accept the papers submitted after 6:00pm IST of the last date prescribed for paper submission.
- 2. Campus Coordinators are requested to submit the papers for their Campus in one consolidated email for each topic to <u>core-comm-imo-mock-session@googlegroups.com</u> from 18th June 2021 to 20th June 2021, 7:00 pm IST. Therefore all Guides and Campus Coordinators are requested to plan their respective Campus paper submission related work in advance.
