Chairperson

The Chairperson will announce the agenda, sequence in which teams will introduce their papers and conduct the proceedings.

Sequence of Events

Each qualified team will be given 3 minutes (uninterrupted) for **Introduction** of their Paper. Teams can scroll their final submitted Paper on screen during the Introduction. **There will be no Presentation**. Time overrun upto maximum 1 minute will not be negatively marked. However, negative marks will be given for time overrun more than 1 minute. At 5 minutes, the team would be stopped regardless. Thereafter each of the other teams would be permitted **one Intervention** each to that Paper. The decision on permitting a Response by the Introducing Team to the Intervention, will be that of the Session Chair.

On completion of these proceedings for the first Paper, the next Paper will be invited for Introduction by the Chair and the same process will be repeated for all qualified Papers in that Subject.

Then the qualified teams of the second subject would follow the same process.

The above proceeding for each paper will be assessed by the Judges and contribute to overall positions.

<u>Advisory</u>

Teams are advised to be ready to introduce their paper, irrespective of the declared sequence and timings, so as to cater for all contingencies.
