

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINAL ROUNDS OF
SECOND IMO MOCK SESSION COMPETITION (2022) – 09 OCTOBER 2022

The Final Rounds of the Second IMO Mock Session Competition (2022) will be held on 09 October 2022 in virtual mode. The event will be streamed live in both Google Meet and YouTube. All students and members of IMU community are hereby requested to strictly adhere to the instructions outlined in the succeeding paragraphs.

Instructions for Students

1. The Google Meet link will be provided only to the Participating Students.
2. All Students participating in the competition shall login either from Laptop OR Desktop. Use of Mobiles by participants is strictly prohibited.
3. All participants are expected to set an appropriate backdrop of their computers & take measures to avoid background noise.
4. Participants need to maintain dress code as prescribed and be properly groomed.
5. All participants are hereby instructed not to make any kind of offending or argumentative statements during the interaction.
6. All participants are expected to maintain decorum of the competition.
7. To avoid any mishap during switching from speaker to speaker, it is recommended that only one speaker introduce the Paper. However, it is up to the teams to decide on number of speakers. However, at least one more team member should be standby to take over from the designated speaker in case there is any requirement to do so.
8. Given the limited time available, there is no need to introduce team members and Campus names. It would be prudent to have a couple of rehearsals prior the main event. Further, it is advised that there is no need to give more than a crisp background, as certain level of knowledge has to be assumed.
9. Teams are advised to be ready to introduce their paper, irrespective of the declared sequence and timings, so as to cater for all contingencies.
10. Teams are advised to use their single Intervention for each Paper after due thought and consideration.

Instructions for Zonal Coordinators & Campus Coordinators

1. Campus coordinators are requested to prepare an authentic list of the participants' email IDs to which the link of the Meet will be shared, and share the same with the Core Committee, through the Zonal Coordinators.
2. Campus Coordinators are requested to help the students resolve any problems pertinent to the competition. In this context, Campus Coordinators may hold a meeting of the qualified teams in advance, to understand the preparedness of the participants.
3. The Online presence of Zonal and Campus coordinators is essential during the Mock Session. All Zonal and Campus Coordinators are therefore requested to make necessary arrangements / take the required permissions from their respective Campuses / Institutes.
4. All Zonal and Campus Coordinators are requested to keep on hand the Names of all members of the Qualified Teams, their Contact Details, and the Final Cut papers of

their respective campuses, and any other information relevant for the effective conduct of the competition.

5. Campus Coordinators are further requested to prepare a list of guests / delegates, in consultation with their Director / Principal, whom they would want to invite for the Final Rounds.

Instructions for Members of the Audience

1. Students from IMU campuses, IMU affiliated colleges, Faculty and staff of IMU community, parents, relatives and friends of Participants are all requested to watch the competition on the YouTube live stream.
