- Unless and until a formal Agreement is prepared and executed, this Tender, together with our written acceptance thereof, shall constitute a binding Contract between us.
- 6. I / We understand that the Indian Maritime University (Chennai Campus) reserves the right to,

- a) Amend the scope of tender and value of contract under this work;
- b) Reject or accept any tender including the lowest, cancel the tender process and reject all tender(s).
  I/We agree that the Indian Maritime University (Chennai Campus) will not be liable for any such action and will be under no obligation to inform the bidder of the grounds for such action.
- 7. If our Tender is accepted we understand that we are held fully responsible for the due performance of the Contract.

We have furnished Earnest Money in the form of Demand Draft in favor of Indian Maritime University, Chennai for an amount of Rs.2,10,000/-. If our Tender is not accepted, the Earnest Money shall be returned to us on our application within a period as specified in the tender. The bidder is requested to acquaint himself with the scope of work, all terms and conditions & penalty details etc. of the complete tender document before quoting the rates.

# The Bidder is required to enclose a separate working sheet for the price quoted in the rows 1 to 3 (above) to provide Security manpower to IMU Chennai Campus. The working sheet must clearly indicate the minimum wages (including VDA), ESI, EPF & any other statutory requirement under the prevalent rules applicable for Zone "A" prescribed by Central Ministry of Labour and Employment, Govt. of India. Please note Bonus not to be included in the price bid – Bonus has to be paid by the contractor as per the Prevailing Bonus Act which will be reimbursed upon submission of proof of payment. However the reimbursement will be as per the minimum bonus amount prescribed in the Bonus Act.

^ The Grand total amount is exclusive of GST rates. The bidder must note that GST shall be applicable extra as prevalent under the rules during the month of rendering housekeeping services to IMU Chennai Campus.

Providing round the clock security services by deploying Security Guards in 08hours shifts as per the schedule mentioned in Section III of Volume I of the tender document and complying with all the conditions stipulated including fulfilling all requirements. The rate should be inclusive of Reliever charges and all taxes \*\*(except GST), levies, duties and service charges etc.

### Note:

- (1) \*\* The wages (per month) quoted by the bidder should not be less than Minimum Wages ([Basic + VDA] per day x 26 days) for Zone 'A' for Watch and Ward without Arms as prescribed by as per the Orders of Office of Chief Labour commissioner (C), Ministry of Labour and Employment, Govt. Of India, as applicable as on the last date of submission of Tender.
- (2) ## ESI, PF should not be less than the statutory provisions / Act by the Central Government. If the amount/rates quoted are less than the prescribed minimum as stated above, then the bid will be disqualified and

rejected. Bidders may restrict the contribution to the statutory minimum which may have to be clearly stated in the price bid above.

- (3) If there is revision in the Minimum Wages prescribed by Central Government under Minimum Wages Act. During the tenure of the contract, then:
  - (i) If the revised minimum wages rates are less than the quoted rates, then rates quoted by the bidder will not be enhanced.
  - (ii) If the revised minimum wages rates are more than the rates quoted by the bidder, then revised minimum wages rates will be considered for reimbursement.
- (4) The initial contract period is for one year and may be extended further by IMUfor a period of two more years on yearly basis, at the option of IMU, subject to the satisfactory performance of the contactor at the same rate and terms and conditions of the contract.
- (5) In casethere is a variation in number of security guards required by IMU to be posted in future (the numbers may increase or decrease), then they would be posted with the existing quoted rates and terms and conditions of the contract. Accordingly, the payment will be made as per the actual strength posted in any particular month.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Central Government Vide Notification No.S.O.191(E) dated 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 of the Ministry of Labour & Employment, the undersigned hereby revise the rates of Variable Dearness Allowance on the basis average consumer price index number for the preceding period of six month ending on 31.12.2018 reaching 301.33 from 288.33 (Base 2001 – 100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 13 points for **Industrial workers** and direct that this order shall come into force w.e.f. 01.04.2019.
