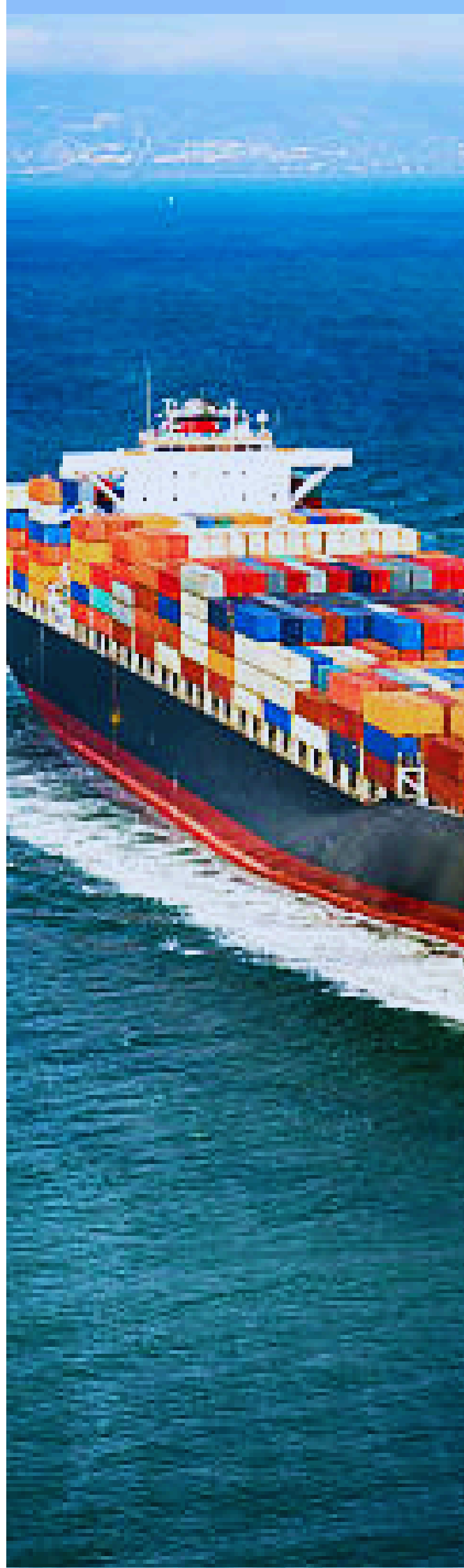

Introduction



IMU is a Teaching-cum-Affiliating University established by an Act of Parliament on 14 November 2008 to provide quality maritime education, training and research. It was created by merging seven (7) erstwhile Institutes:

- i. Training Ship Chanakya, Mumbai (T.S. Chanakya)
- ii. Marine Engineering and Research Institute (MERI), Mumbai
- iii. Marine Engineering and Research Institute (MERI), Kolkata
- iv. Lal Bahadur Shastri Centre for Advanced Maritime Studies (LBSCAMSAR), Mumbai
- v. National Maritime Academy (NMA), Chennai
- vi. Indian Institute of Port Management (IIPM), Kolkata
- vii. National Ship Design and Research Centre (NSDRC), Visakhapatnam

Institutes No. (i) to (iv) were Central Government Institutes

Institutes No. (v) to (vii) were 'Registered Societies'.





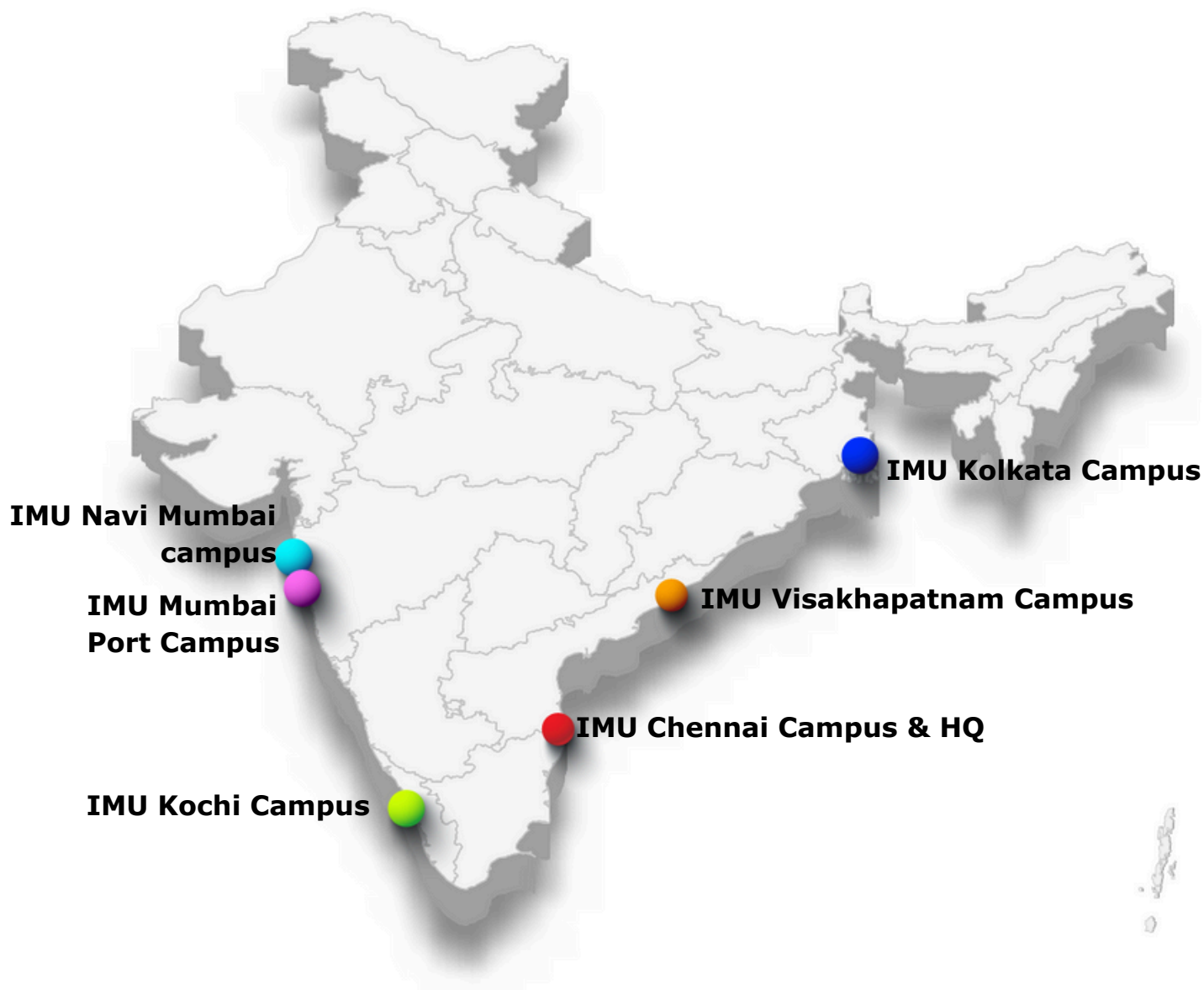
Prior to 14.11.2008, T.S. Chanakya, MERI-Mumbai and MERI-Kolkata were undergraduate colleges. T.S. Chanakya was affiliated to Mumbai University for the 3-year B. Sc. (Nautical Science) programme and to IGNOU for the 1-year Diploma in Nautical Science (DNS) programme. MERI-Mumbai offered 3-year B.Sc.-Maritime Science (under affiliation of Mumbai University) and 1-year Graduate Mechanical Engineers (GME) programme through which Mechanical Engineers could pursue a sailing career.

MERI, Kolkata was affiliated to Jadavpur University for the 4-year B. Tech (Marine Engineering) programme.

LBSCAMSAR, Mumbai was a training institution offering short-term post-sea training programmes to seafarers.

NMA Chennai and IIPM Kolkata were training institutions offering short - term programmes to Port officers. NSDRC, Visakhapatnam was a research organization.

Headquartered in Chennai, IMU has 6 Campuses located at Chennai, Kochi, Kolkata, Mumbai, Navi Mumbai and Visakhapatnam. The erstwhile institute T. S. Chanakya became the Navi Mumbai Campus and the erstwhile institute MERI Mumbai & LBS CAMSAR became the Mumbai Port Campus respectively; the erstwhile institutes MERI Kolkata & IIPM became the Kolkata Campus; the erstwhile National Maritime Academy became the Chennai Campus of IMU; and the erstwhile National Ship Design and Research Centre became the Visakhapatnam Campus of IMU.

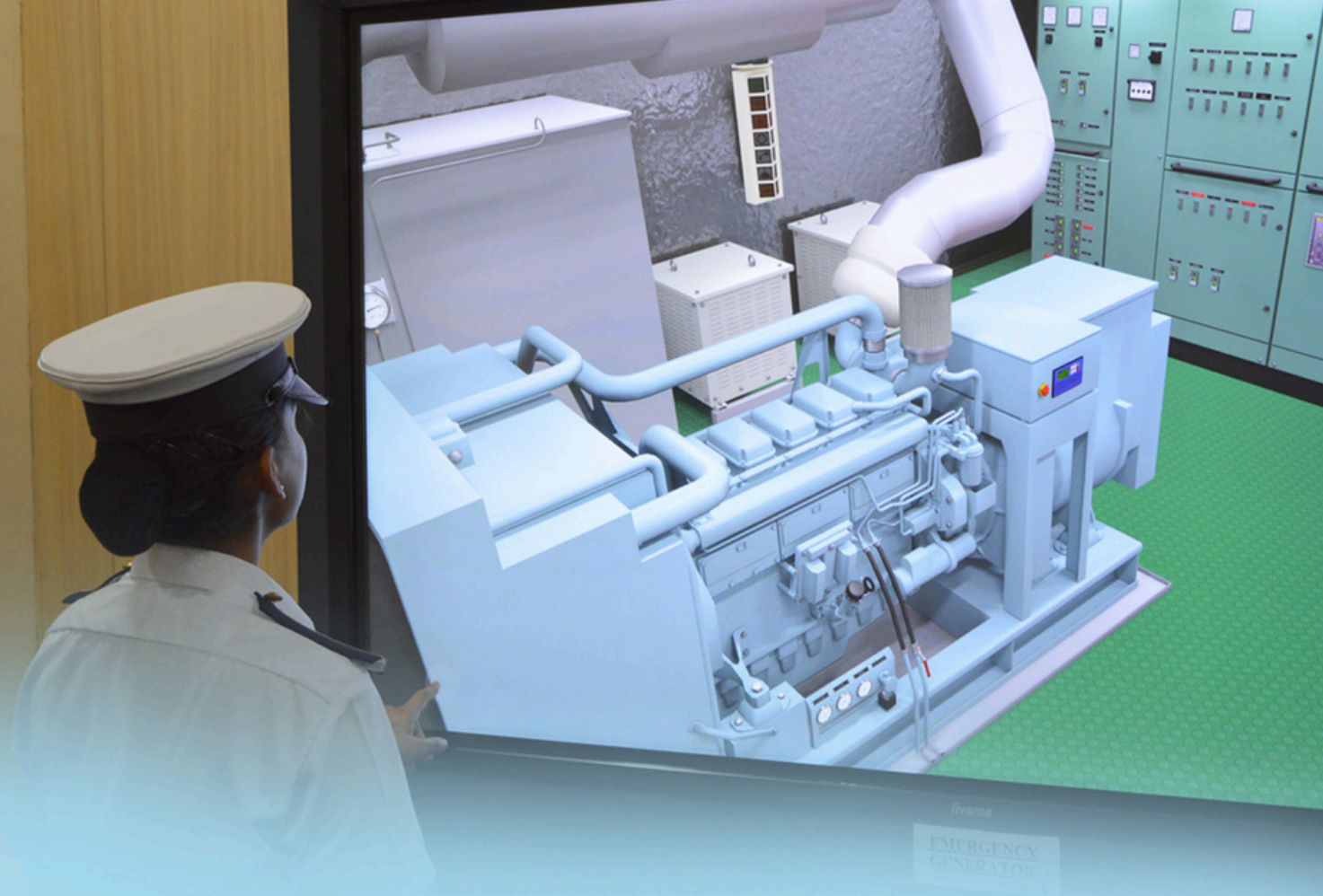

About Chennai Campus

The Chennai campus has a history dating back to 1984 when the National Institute of Port Management (NIPM) was established by the Government of India as an independent body. The NIPM provided professional training courses to individuals working in the ports sector with technical assistance from UNDP/UNCTAD.

In 2006, the institute was rebranded as the National Maritime Academy (NMA) with an expanded role to train professionals from all sectors of the maritime industry, including ports. In 2008, NMA was merged with IMU to become the Chennai Campus of IMU.

IMU Chennai Campus is located at about 25 Kms. from the city centre, on the picturesque East Coast Road on way to Mahabalipuram. It is spread over 20 acres with a scenic beachfront on the outskirts of Chennai and has ISO-9001:2015 & CIP grading A. The Campus houses the academic block, hostel, residential and recreational facilities, multi-gymnasium, and spacious auditoriums in both its Uthandi and Semmencherry premises.

Chennai Campus prides itself for not only being a legacy Institute but also for being a part of the rapid development the University is undergoing. Chennai Campus has Programmes on offer from three Schools and the students of all the Programmes receive laurels and appreciation regularly for many extracurricular activities from the industry stakeholders and others.

The Campus has been building on these positives, which is evident from the year-after-year increase in the number of industry stakeholders visiting the Campus for placements and other activities. IMU posits itself as a significant knowledge partner in driving India's Maritime Vision to be a global leader. Under the University, IMU Chennai Campus is a vibrant centre for maritime academics and research contributing to this endeavor.

Located at Willingdon Island, IMU's Kochi Campus was inaugurated on a 2.6 Acre plot of land on lease from Cochin Port Trust. Subsequently the campus was relocated to the present, sprawling 10-acre campus in September 2016.

About Kolkata Campus

IMU's Kolkata Campus is the oldest and largest amongst the University's constituent Campuses. It symbolises the birth of Marine Engineering training in India. The Institution was established at the onset of independence in 1947 to satisfy the growing need of Marine Engineers in India. It was founded in 1949 by Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru as 'Directorate of Marine Engineering Training' (DMET) with its headquarters at Calcutta and a branch at Bombay, under the erstwhile Ministry of Transport, GoI.

The institution was established in line with the tenets of the Constitution of India, viz., 'Maritime shipping and navigation, including shipping and navigation on tidal waters; provision of education and training for the mercantile marine and regulation of such education and training provided by States and other agencies. Subsequently, a sprawling Campus was established at Taratala Road.

The institution was renamed 'Marine Engineering and Research Institute (MERI)' in 1995. After the formation of Indian Maritime University in 2008, MERI became a part of the Indian Maritime University, Kolkata Campus (IMU-KC).

The erstwhile Indian Institute of Port Management (IIPM), Kolkata, (estd. 1965) was subsumed as a part of the IMU, Kolkata Campus (IMU-KC) in 2008.

The Campus, spreads over 33 acres, has state-of-the-art infrastructure and facilities which include well-equipped class rooms, electrical & mechanical laboratories, hostel accommodations, ship simulators, a modern library, a fully equipped Olympic-size swimming pool cum life-saving training facility, a spacious auditorium, an Assembly Hall for seminars, an infirmary with medical assistance, a multi-gymnasium, an expansive workshop with various shops and a Ship in Campus with one full-size, 6000 BHP marine propulsion Engine for training of the cadets.

The Campus has been playing a pioneering role in producing competent personnel for the maritime sector. The faculty have been carrying out research and development in many maritime topics and have publications in IEEE and other reputed international journals.

The institute also undertakes consultancy and research projects, sponsored by both the Government and the maritime industry.

The IMU Mumbai Port Campus is one of the premier maritime education and research centres in India. The Campus is located at Hay Bunder Road in Sewri, Mumbai, with a sea-front of the Mumbai's inner harbor.

The Campus comprises two legacy institutes, the Lal Bahadur Shastri College of Advanced Maritime Studies & Research (LBS CAMSAR estb. 1948) and the Marine Engineering & Research Institute (MERI) (erstwhile DMET est. 1949), which were subsumed with IMU in 2008. These institutes have been training maritime personnel for more than 7 decades and are well-respected for their contribution to the Global maritime industry.

The Campus offers a wide range of undergraduate and postgraduate programs in the fields of nautical science and marine engineering. The Campus has a boat-pool with motorboats, whalers, and lifesaving boats for practical training and learning. The IMU Navi Mumbai Campus (NMC), is situated at Karave, Nerul, Navi Mumbai, within the eco sensitive area between Palm beach road and the Vashi Creek Mangroves near jewel of Navi Mumbai Lake. The Flamingo bay is also attached just outside the IMU-NMC Campus.

The genesis of the Campus goes back to 1927, when nautical training was initiated on the Training Ship Dufferin, in the year 1922. Following the decommissioning of Dufferin, the training of cadets continued on the TS Rajendra from 1972. T.S RAJENDRA was named in the memory of Chola Emperor Rajendra.

T.S Rajendra was replaced by a shore- based academy, TS Chanakya, in 1993. TS Chanakya was subsumed into the IMU in 2008.

The IMU Visakhapatnam Campus has its origins from the India's premier ship design and maritime research institution, the National Ship Design and Research Centre. Pioneered in the early 90`s by the Government of India to pilot and consolidate national domain knowledge with global vision, NSDRC has undertaken several milestone projects in the areas of Ship Design, Construction and Applied Research.

The Campus has two premises: The Gandhigram which is within the city limits and has self-contained academic and administrative blocks, Workshops, hostels, multi-gymnasium and mess facilities. The other is located at Vangali village, Sabbavaram Mandal of Visakhapatnam.

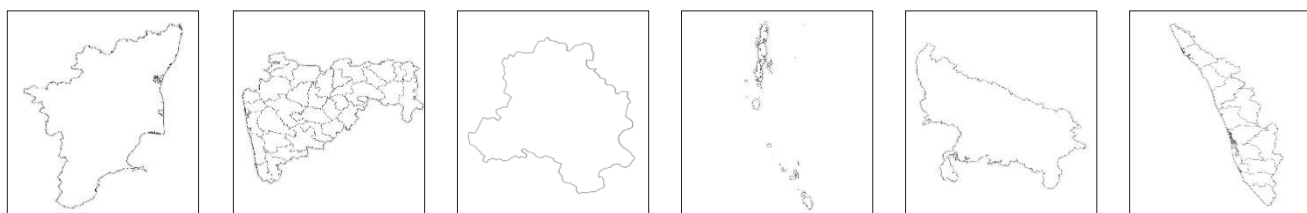


6.6. Affiliated Institutes

7.1. Academic Initiatives

- **New Programme Launch:** 4-year B.Tech Naval Architecture and Ship Building (NASB); IMU Vizag Campus.
- **Minor Degree Options:** B.Tech (Marine Engineering); Minor Degree (any one): Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics.
- **Inclusivity Initiatives:** Admission of Transgender Candidates in B.Tech (NAOE & NASB) and BBA programmes offered in IMU Chennai and Visakhapatnam.
- **Simultaneous Pursuit of Degree Programmes:** Students of B.Tech (NAOE), B.Tech (NASB), B.Sc. (SBR), BBA and PG programmes can pursue another academic programme simultaneously from any University.
- **Process Improvement:** Examination process has been streamlined (introduction of Supplementary Examinations, swifter evaluation of answer scripts, zero delays in declaration of exam results etc.)

7.2. Introduction of University Fellowship Scheme:

- IMU offers M.S (By Research), Ph.D. and Integrated Ph.D. Programmes since 2017 to promote research and development in emerging areas such as maritime spatial planning, integrated maritime surveillance, maritime laws, maritime security, search and rescue, transportation of dangerous cargo, environmental studies, blue economy, marine data and knowledge, sea basin strategies, and other related fields.
- In line with these objectives, IMU has instituted the 'University Ph.D. Fellowship' scheme, which is in line with fellowships offered by national institutions and universities of repute. The aim of this fellowship scheme is to support postgraduate students pursuing research in the maritime domain. For the Academic Year 2024, 3 full time Research Scholars have been admitted under the scheme.

7.3. Centre for Policy Research in Maritime Studies (C-PRiMeS)

The Union Minister of Ports, Shipping & Waterways and Ayush, Shri. Sarbananda Sonowal, inaugurated the Centre for Policy Research in Maritime Studies (C-PRiMeS) on 4 November 2022. This centre is dedicated to maritime studies and will function as a think tank, driving the development of the maritime economy:

10.2. Global Maritime India Summit [GMIS] 2023

IMU, participated in the GMIS held from 17 to 19 October 2023 in Mumbai. This event was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri. Narendra Modi and saw participation from top leaders from the Ministries, maritime industries from India and abroad and Ministerial delegations from many Countries.

IMU's e-library was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, GoI, Shri. Narayan Tatu Rane. IMU's revamped website was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of State for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, GoI, Shri. Shripad Naik.

MoUs were inked with Erasmus University, UPT; LoI signed under the Indo-Dutch collaborations, the GoI, Erasmus UPT had conducted an online micro credit course and also delivered lectures at IMU.

Eastern University (EU), Trincomalee Campus, Sri Lanka has offerings in areas of applied sciences, business studies etc. The EU seeks India's support to develop marine related programmes. 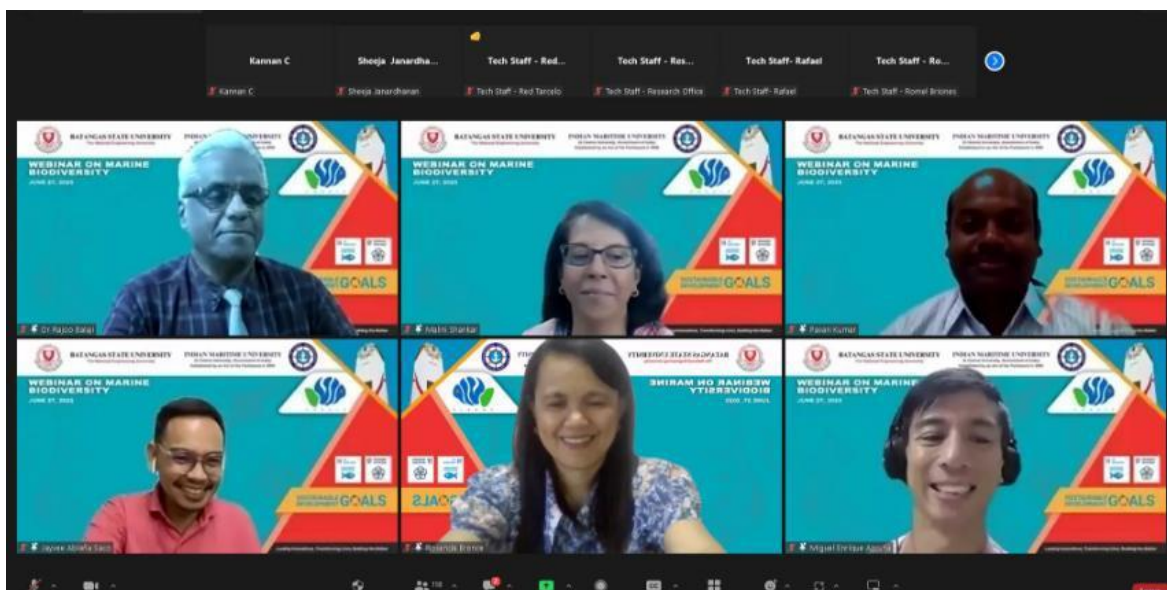
